Motion by Goettsch to approve Good Conduct Policy as presented, seconded by Patterson. All Ayes.

Board reviewed IVCSD Projects. The board will move forward with a new press box for the football field, bathroom partitions, security upgrades, installation of new windows (1st floor this year, 2nd floor next year), bleachers for elementary and high school gym, and resurface parking lot at high school (set for after school is dismissed for the school year).
