1. Adam Rabe contacted me that Iowa County EMS has several re-furbished AED machines for a cost of \$726.50 which includes a 3-year parts and labor warranty. The cost for an additional cabinet is \$107.21 for a total of \$833.71. Adam also shared that they can do CPR/AED training as well as Stop the Bleed training from a grant they received. We will be working on trainings for our staff in both of these areas- CPR/AED training and Stop the Bleed.
2. GWAEA Supt. meeting was held on May 2. The first 2.5 hours was spent on reviewing two Culture Assessments. IDI was used with the Cedar Rapids CSD and HUMANeX was used at Washington CSD and Mid-Prairie
